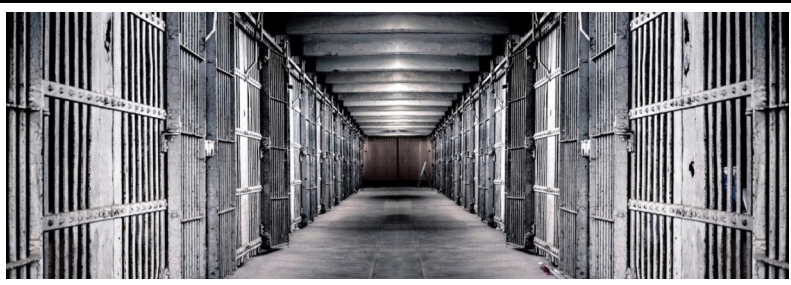

Ms. Teresa Njoroge



is a successful ex-offender who Co-founded and serves as CEO of Clean Start Solutions. CSS is a social enterprise that seeks to restore hope, dignity, self confidence and self respect to those leaving prisons, enabling them to break the cycle of poverty and prison, by empowering them to have decent sustainable means of livelihood, in Kenya.

Mr. Terry O'Connell



is a 30-year Australian police veteran who developed the *restorative conference script*. He is the recently retired Australian Director for Real Justice, a sister organization to the Bethlehem, PA based International Institute for Restorative Practices.

Ms. Shirley Moore Smeal



is the Executive Deputy Secretary for the Pennsylvania Department of Corrections, a position she has held since April 2010. In this position, she is second in command of the agency responsible for nearly 16,000 staff and over 50,000 inmates.

Mr. James Forman Jr.



is a former Washington DC Public Defender and co-founded the Maya Angelou Public Charter School.
