PSYCHIATRIC STABILIZATION

- Thorough psychiatric evaluation and medication assisted stabilization
- Full time psychiatrist on staff and available 24-hours daily
- Full and complete medical examination and history
- Nursing care 24-hours daily
- Therapeutic groups and activities with a small group focus
- Family and individual therapy as recommended by Roxbury's treatment team
- Structured recreational therapy including art and music therapies
- Continuing care resources and detailed after care and crisis plan
